MAY SING THE BLUES tracked the first flight from the two path, picked way through some traffic in the turn, engaged the leader nearing the furlong grounds, quickly clear, finished full of run to win ridden out. GO PUBLIC vied early along the inside, shuffled back while continuing inside, came back for the place after moving off the inside late. MELVIN broke alertly, narrowly set the pace while just off the inside, proved no match for the winner the final furlong, caught late for the place. DREAM ON SILKY with the pace three wide, continued to vie while between foes through the turn, had little left for the drive. MOSS LAKE with the pace while widest, five path into the turn, was beginning to weaken when four wide out of the bend, continued to tired. DUCK GUMBO contested the pace four wide and between foes into the turn, gave way.
