Non-winners of a sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2011 allowed 2 lbs.; non-winners of two races other than maiden, claiming, or starter at a mile or over in 2011 allowed 4 lbs.; non-winners of a race other than maiden, claiming, or starter at a mile or over in 2011 allowed 6 lbs. The Honeymoon will be limited to twelve (12) starters. Preference to horses with the highest earnings in 2010-2011. LOCAL never far back along the inside, surpassed by entymate backstretch, moved out second turn, roused for the drive, late bid, finished willingly to prevail. SKIPPING TOWN pressured the early leader from the outside, moved up to join that foe after a half, dueled through the second turn, shook clear, could not contain the winner. HISSE settled off the early pace, moved closer with a middle move late backstretch second turn, raced on equal terms with entymate upper stretch, flattened out a bit late. MUFFIN went one paced throughout in lacking a late kick. PRETTY NOT last away, void of early foot in trailing for six furlongs, showed some belated interest down the lane while out in the course. WANNA CUDDLE lacked a closing bid while racing off the inside. OPPORTUNITY LOST had nothing for the drive. THE BOSSER remained back throughout in also lacking a rally. SAINT BELINDA sprinted clear early, set or forced the pace for six furlongs then gave way.
