**Footnotes**

LEESTOWNS FINALE toward the front out of the chute, raced in the second flight under confident handling, lacked room toward the rail when trying to get through turning for home, fell back a bit,split foes past the furlong marker, fully extended to narrowly prevail. TIME LIMIT off the early pace, ranged up to challenge with a bold move four wide late in the turn, gained the advantage, gave ground grudgingly to the winner late. DR. GRAUSTARK lacked speed, steered out to be four wide turning into the stretch, finished up best of the rest while well out in the strip. LYPHARD'S GOLD forwardly placed on the outside, vied three wide out of the turn when with the leaders, weakened. PEANUT TWO narrowly set the pace for a half toward the inside, faltered in the drive. ICKY BOB KRANE void of speed in trailing for a half, passed tiring rivals. EL GATO GRANDE made little impact toward the rail. CLASSY DRESSER stumbled start, did not menace. LIGHTSTOWN vied up front off the rail, was tiring between foes when forced to steady entering the stretch, continued to fade. WHATS UP MACK finished after a half.
