Footnotes

PRINT never far back, took over turning for home, long drive, responded when challenged late, dug in in a determined effort. POINT MINISTER allowed the pace to go early, began a steady advance before a half, outside bid, outfinished. GO FASTER FOREST dueled up front while off the inside, held a narrow advantage in the second turn, vied past the furlong marker, weakened the final furlong. MARKET MOVER bobbled at the start, settled off the pace, came four wide into the lane when making a modest advance, finished up evenly. FIEND A BIT void of early foot, continued to trail after a half, made a belated run up the rail. RARE WIND within striking distance, had little left in the drive. ACTUAL FACT lacked speed, improved position while not a threat. PLENTY O'JACK tired. UNCLE WHO last away, passed tiring foes. WELDON vied up front closest to the inside, gave way. PAYNE DISTINCTION finished after a half. LITTLE FOOLS DAY gave way late backstretch, stopped, distanced.
