Footnotes

TALLNESS tucked in early in the first turn to avoid a pair of foes and to save some ground, continued unhurried up the backstretch, moved out to be four wide 2nd turn, rallied, late surge to be in time. GOLDPAL forwardly placed, traffic, in hand entering stretch, lacked room briefly with a sixteenth to run, split foes, led late, nipped at wire. TRIBUTE TO HANNAH forwardly placed off the inside, moved closer to force the issue second turn and into the stretch, continued to press the leader with a furlong remaining, weakened late. TIKA SOUP got clear into the first turn, set the pace until faltering with less than a furlong remained. HER LAKE TERLINGUA made little impact while three wide turning for home. BATUM forwardly placed in the early going, tired from those efforts. HIGH CLASS GIRL void of any type of early foot, passed a few tiring foes. SNAZZY SLEW SUE staged a steady retreat. J P'S LUCKY GAIL behind the early pace when carried out to the six path into the first turn, advanced four wide into a forward position before a half, continued four wide through the second turn then tired. SWEET LOUELLEN bore out into the first turn, settled in the run up the backstretch then faded.
