SEFAPIANO JR. off the pace, saved some ground in the second turn, angled out for the drive and closed with good energy to be in time. KRISTENS REBEL set the pace, clear before a quarter, moderate pace, repulsed a bid past the furlong marker, got clear again, caught late. WITH ATTITUDE within striking distance, saved some ground, moved out, challenged into the lane, hung in the late going. HUNGARIAN CAT last speed, dropped inside for the drive, improved position. JUNE AFTERNOON devoid of early foot, trailed for five furlongs, also improved position by displaying some belated interest. BOSTON MYSTERY moved up into a forward position after a half, faltered in the drive. BEE BAYOU chased the runner up for six furlongs and tired. FIREFROMTHEBAYOU lacked a response in the drive. DAKOTA FLAME tired. PICK YOUR TARGET was never close. TOPVENTURE'S DREAM staged a steady retreat.
