WILDRALLY unhurried early while toward the inside, advanced through traffic, challenged when straightened for home, long drive, proved best in a determined effort. SIMPLE KIND OF MAN took up to avoid a stricken rival in the first turn and moved out four wide, fell back, ranged up five wide late in the second turn into a striking position, challenged past the furlong marker, missed. WARREN'S MARK lacked speed, raced back, made a good gain along the inside into the lane, moved out, just up for the show. CREAM LEVEL forward early, took over before a half, showed the way into the lane, weakened a bit, nipped late for the show. COLD EAST WIND lacked speed, improved with a mild rally four wide. GUILTY PLEA within striking distance, some traffic backstretch, had little left for the drive. MARKET MOVER off slowly, was never a factor. FIRST BOY took up to avoid a stricken foe first turn, moved out five wide, advanced to press the pace, gave way in the drive. RED OAK RIDGE early pace, stopped after a half. TOUCHDOWN JESUS forward early, broke down in the first turn.
