Footnotes

PATTER FLATTER away in good order, settled in the second flight early while three wide, chased the leader into the far turn, collared that rival soon after, long drive, edging away late under pressure. HALEY'S MAJIC broke alertly, soon got clear and to the inside, set the pace, responded when the winner challenged in the second turn and proved stubborn through the lane. THE BARN MANAGER within striking distance along the inside early, fell back, bit closer second turn, lacked a winning kick in the drive. STACEY LEE settled off the pace and the inside, came up empty in the drive. SEFAS LIGHT off the early pace, ranged up into contention while four wide late in the final turn, gave way in the drive. FLYING BINGO was never close.
