T. C. CHAMP set the pace from the start, drew steadily out in the stretch, driving. MUST BE HE lacked speed, came five wide into the stretch, finished willingly to be clear for the place, no match for the winner. ELLERTON well back early, advanced with a four wide middle move into contention, closest to the winner a furlong out, caught late for the place. SUBMEDIANT back early, raced four wide second turn, roused turning for home, lacked needed response. ROCKY ON THE RED raced back, improved position while no real threat. ASHLEYS IRISH LADD saved ground while within striking distance, lacked clear room midway second turn, came up empty when clear. ROSE COUNTRY MAN taken in hand, trailed, picked off some tiring foes while never dangerous. BIG FOREST lacked a rally. JENNY'S SAY faded. SOMEWHEREINMONTANA chased the winner for five furlongs, gave way. PARADE THE FLAG four wide first turn, moved closer three wide and between foes third quarter, stopped in the drive.
