CAESAR'S COIN away in good order, showed the way past the wire the first time, well rated in the run up the backstretch, larger lead into the lane, kept to task. MASTER JEHU away alertly, taken back to trail early, continued back, roused, moved off the inside second turn, rallied through traffic to be clear for the place. SALT DADDY broke out, closest to the winner, continued to chase through the final turn, could do little with that rival in the drive, no match for the runner up late, saved the show. EMPTY PAGES off a bit slow, moved up a bit, turned in an even effort while gaining for the show spot late. FIEND A BIT bothered, steadied at the start, never a threat. K D'S BIG MAC within striking distance early, began to fade after a half.
