Footnotes

STRING KING broke a bit top the inside, pressured the pace while off the inside, challenged the leader in the second turn, put a head in front soon after, drew strongly clear in upper stretch. TRICKY AND QUICK void of speed while saving ground, steered out for room exiting the final turn, rallied willingly through and around traffic to be clear for the place. MANCHAC settled off the inside, raced closest to the winner past the furlong marker, could do little with that foe, also proved no match for the runner up in the final strides. MONETARY UNION raced off the pace, came in the two path out of the final turn, lacked a significant response in the drive. DOUBLE STEAL within striking distance, raced in some traffic out of the final turn, lacked a closing kick when clear for the drive. FIRST CROWNED outrun in the early going, advanced, lodged a bid with a four wide middle move in the far turn, faltered in the drive. A MILLION FIELDS had little left for the drive. CAJUN STREAKER broke on top, set the pace for almost six furlongs, gave way when headed second turn. COASTAL RALLY bothered slightly when the winner broke in a bit at the start, trailed throughout.
