AMANECER DE ORO forwardly placed early, stalked the two leaders through the turn, closer into lane, collared leader, drove clear. BOLD RECRUIT broke sharp, set a quick pace while being pushed through the turn, shook off the other speed to be briefly clear past the furlong marker, had nothing for the winner, just lasted for the place. VERY POSSEBULL pressured the leader through those quick fractions, fell back off that foe when straightened for home, reclosed the gap on that foe late while also no match for the winner, also just lasted for the show. ZARBY'S DERBY DAY off slowly, raced well back, steadied in traffic turning for home, moved out around a tiring foe, steered back to the rail and showed some late interest. PATRYKUS bobbed at the start and steadied, trailed, also encountered some traffic late in the turn, altered course to the far outside for the drive and improved position. SPACE PROBES QUEST lacked a closing response. THE REVEREND JAMES had little left for the drive. SLIGHTLY USED wide trip, tired. ROANA'S ROAR chased the early pace, retreated.
