Footnotes

GOOD SAILING allowed the pace to go early, saved ground, moved out for the drive, bid, took over inside the furlong grounds, held the runner up safe late under steady handling. SERMONETTES HOPE raced off the pace, began to inch closer in the second turn while in traffic, three out to four wide entering the stretch, set down for the drive, finished well to be closing the gap on the winner late. TRESS showed the way into the first turn, remained clear while rating the middle half, had little for the top two the final furlong, lasted for the show. LOVE'S IN STYLE settled off the pace four five furlongs, moved closer in the second turn, flattened out in the drive in lacking a late punch. TRUPELLADEVILLE back off the early pace, made a nice move while five wide through the second turn, hung in the drive. SWEET ACTION trailed early, passed some tiring foes after the issue had been decided. HAGGITH off a step sloe, failed to menace. BRITT'S SPECIAL closest to the leader for five furlongs, gave way. SUAVE AFFAIR within striking distance, gave way while four wide turning for home.
