KATY'S KITTEN in the second flight early while saving ground, moved closer along the inside into the far turn, moved out for the drive, challenged late, won going away. MISS SWEET DREAMS prompted the pace while off the inside, took over turning for home, got clear, no match for the winner late. ALL TIME lacked speed off the inside, moved out to be four wide turning for home, rallied out in the course and was going well at the end. OPPORTUNITY LOST off the pace, in some traffic while three wide turning for home, improved position slightly while not a serious threat. JAKE'S TUITION narrowly set the early pace, got clear before a half, weakened when headed by the runner up turning for home. XIANO last away, trailed well back, came six wide into the stretch, improved slightly. BURNINGRICH slight bother at the start, back off the pace, in some traffic late in the final turn and upper stretch, came up empty when clear. MEAFAREL'S REWARD raced mid pack early, tired from those efforts. LEEOLA forwardly placed for a half, gave way.
