Footnotes

JOHN'S BROWN BEAR helped set the pace three wide and between foes, came in to tighten up inner foes midway in the run up the backstretch, shook clear second turn, headed, came back in a game effort. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE RUN UP THE BACKSTRETCH, JOHN'S BROWN BEAR WAS DISQUALIFIED FOR INTERFERENCE AND PLACED FOURTH. FORTUNE HALL with the pace between foes, steadied when put in tight with five furlong remaining, fell back a bit, rebid outside, put a head in front, outfinished. S P WARRIOR last away, trailed for five furlongs, saved some ground in the second turn, swung out suddenly turning for home, finished well to be rapidly gaining on the top two. STAR SPLASH with the pace inside, checked up along the rail when in tight five furlongs out, fell back and went evenly. PRENTISS lacked a serious late bid. MARGOS WALKER four wide when with the pace through the first turn, continued to vie in the run up the backstretch, prompted the first place finisher through the second turn then gave way in the drive. SILVER NUGGET finished early, far back.
