OUR BROTHER STEVE asked a bit early to take command after breaking with the field, set the pace, clear upper stretch, held sway late. SILVER NICKEL off the early pace, moved closer outside late turn, came five wide into the lane, finished willingly to be clear for the place. MACEY'S CAREBELL closest to the winner most of the way, could not repel the runner up late. LE SEUR went evenly throughout in the three path. RED OAK RIDGE in the second flight toward but not on the rail, roused late turn, managed little in the way of a response. PATSY'S PROM DATE last to leave, was never dangerous. HELLO BUD remained back throughout. A J'S FASHION forwardly placed in the early going, back up inside. DISTINCT DANGER trailed throughout in a dull effort.
