SLICEOFSPACESHOT unhurried early, bothered slightly when a foe got out first turn, remained back, began to advance along the inside second turn, angled out under clever handling into the straight, closed with a rush to be in time. GO PUBLIC broke on top, set the pace, shook well clear stretch, could not contain the winner, remained clear for the place. BLUEHARD settled off the pace, moved closer along the inside turning for home, flattened out a bit in the late going to finish up best of the rest. PIONEERING NATIVE lacked speed, raced in some traffic when roused turning for home, improved slightly while no real threat. MILITARY OFFICER chased the runner up for six furlongs and began to weaken. GOOD FLAMIN FRYDIE steadied past the wire the first time in traffic near the back, got out a bit into the first turn, five wide out of the second bend, failed to rally. HIT THE ROAD LEE settled off the pace, tired in the drive. JEDEDIAH staged a steady retreat.
