Footnotes

NOLAN'S REVENGE unhurried early, came three wide out of the final turn while still well back, moved out for room, staged a willing rally to be in time well out in the course. SOUTHERN VALUES stalked the early pace off the inside moved up to join the fray into the far turn, dueled into and through upper stretch, garnered a larger advantage late, could not contain the winner. ROCKITTOWN allowed to settle while within striking distance, moved closer into straight, mild bid, lacked winning kick late. HI HO CHEERIO narrowly set the pace inside, dueled into the lane with the runner up, weakened final furlong. SIERRA MAESTRA hopped at the start, raced back, improved into the lane off the inside, flattened out a bit the final eighth. JUNE AFTERNOON failed to rally. MIZZEN MAZE pressured the pace for six furlongs between rivals and gave way. ARISTOCAT REX was finished early, wide, outrun.
