BIG LAKE lacked speed, began to rally in traffic out of the turn, dropped to the inside, finished full of run up the rail, won going away. BG HI HI IS BEN back off the pace, rallied through traffic, finished willingly to be up for the place. SUPER BRAD settled off the pace, came in the second flight while between foes into the lane, bid, brief lead, no match winner, caught for place. HUMBLE CAT off the pace, came five wide into the lane, finished up evenly. HILLJACKER in the second group three wide, lacked a kick the final furlong. NOT SO WILD lacked speed, four wide into the lane, managed little rally. PROSPECTORS RIDGE vied up front while closest to the inside, weakened in the drive. ZOOMING BULL broke sharp, narrowly set the pace, gave way. BEAU THE LINE remained back. MASTER JIM JR. always outrun. FORGETOLEDAN forwardly placed along the inside, stopped in the drive. MAJESTIC HOUR broke awkwardly, six wide midway on the turn, backed up drive.
