YONAGUSKA STORM prominent from the start, dueled into the lane closet to the inside, put the other speed away with less than a furlong remaining and edged clear. ALL ABOUT INTEREST prompted the early pace from the outside, dueled outside the winner through the turn and into the stretch, could not keep up the final eighth, well clear for the place. MALACO off the early pace, moved a bit closer while four wide late in the turn, closest to the top two a furlong out, could do little with that pair to the wire, saved the show. BLUFFALATTA broke in, bumped with foe to be last away, well back early, three wide out of the turn, angled out a bit for the drive and was coming late while out in the strip. BIG LEVI went evenly while racing just off the inside. DEDUCT within striking distance for a half, had little fort the drive. CHICKAWAW CHARLIE in the second flight early while between foes, also came up empty for the drive. ARCTIC PRODUCTION trailed early, improved position while never a factor. LOGAN HALL tired while racing outside. BWANA bumped at the start, moved up quickly to vie inside, began to weaken after three furlongs. MALCOLM was never a threat. STRING ATTACK was always outrun.
