SHEZA TENPINS rated off the pace leaving the chute toward the inside, in traffic while continuing toward the rail late in the turn, steered out once straightened for home, in time outside. IDEBEHOLY within striking distance from the start, moved closer while three wide in the turn, vied past the furlong marker, put a head in front, could not contain the winner. PRECIOUS PRESENT last to leave, raced back early, managed a steady gain four wide through the turn, lost some ground into the the lane to the leader, roused, up late for the show. MISS LA PRISS moved up to show the way early, continued to set the pace turn, held a narrow advantage with a furlong to run, weakened when headed by the runner up soon after. LASTCALL FOR YALL fell back to trail soon after the start, continued to see them all out of the turn, picked off a couple of tiring rivals after the issue had been decided. IT'S A TALE raced in mid pack early, tired in the drive. HONKY TONKS HEAT away well, prompted the early pace along the inside, backed up through the stretch.
