FAMULA (ARG) last to leave, began to move late in the second turn, angled out to be widest of all in the drive, up just in time. DANCINASFASTASICAN also lacked speed, made a quick move four wide to reach contention in the second turn, showed the way past the furlong marker, caught by the winner in the waning strides. I. B.'S HALO raced in the second flight off the rail, in traffic turning for home, along for the show while not a threat to the top two. CIEL CLASSIC forwardly placed, challenged between foes into the second turn, showed the way into the stretch, faltered. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER NATIVE MILLU AGAINST THE RIDER OF CIEL CLASSIC FOR INTIMIDATING HIS MOUNT WITH THE WHIP WAS NOT ALLOWED. NATIVE MILLU advanced into a striking position after a half, outside challenge into the far turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. K J'S GIRL closest to the leader for five furlongs, had nothing left for the drive. FREE STYLIN' sprinted clear to set the pace for five furlongs, gave way. LITTLERIVERQUEEN was finished before a half.
