ROYAL MADAME a pace factor from the start along the inside, drew clear through the lane under pressure. CLEVER THIRTEEN settled off the pace, saved all the ground, drew a bit closer while continuing inside when straightened for home, no match the final furlong. OH WHATA HOLIDAY void of early foot, steady advance the middle half through some traffic, closest to the winner into the stretch, flattened out, outkicked late for the place. PRODUCTION'S IDOL vied early outside the winner, chased that one through the final turn and began to weaken. WILDCAT CALLIE was never dangerous. PLACE SAINT MICHEL had little for the drive. CALLIOPE JANE was finished after a half.
