### Footnotes

CLEVER SHOES forwardly placed along the inside early, fell back a bit into the turn, advanced, challenged while continuing along the rail inside the furlong marker, proved best with some good late energy. DIAMOND BLADE away well, showed the way early, continued to set the pace in the two path into the lane, allowed the winner the rail late, outfinished. WILDCAT CHARMS prompted the pace while racing off the inside, continued to be within striking distance stretch, lacked a winning kick late. ONE TRUE SUN lacked speed, angled out to be five wide into the stretch, improved position out in the middle of the strip. LYDGATE'S PROOF in the second flight outside, raced four out to five wide through the turn, went evenly in the drive. DEPUTY RED within striking distance, raced in some traffic late in the turn, clear for the drive, also finished up evenly. EVIL OFFICER raced four wide and off the pace through the turn, failed to muster a rally. WAR CHIEF last to leave, was never close. KRISTI'S UPGRADE lacked speed, five wide out of the turn, stayed back.
