PIONEER GAL unhurried early, ranged up outside to challenge in the turn, wore down the leader the final furlong. ALY ETBAUER close from the start, took over in the turn off the inside, gave ground grudgingly in the drive. DE'S SWEET DREAM settled off the pace and well of the rail, along for the show. ZARB'S ROSE a bit slow in leaving, raced back, displayed some belated interest down the center of the track. RAINBOW KISSES lacked a bid in the drive. I'MACOUNTRYGAL with the first flight, vied between foes late in the turn, gave way. AGGIEINFRONT pinched start, not a threat. MILITARY DREAM was not a factor. MISS TUFFET remained always back. NIKKI'S JOY flashed brief speed inside and stopped.
