Footnotes

WASH PARK broke with the field, moved up to take over from the rail soon after, set all the pace, expanded advantage into the stretch, drew well clear under steady urging. POWERSCOUT vied up front outside the winner, proved no match for that rival, clearly second best. PRIZED TOP CAT off the early pace, moved closer four wide in the turn, could do little more with the top two in the drive, clear of the others. BAND OF FUN last away, raced well back, displayed a modest amount of late interest while never dangerous. J P'S BIG GARY lacked a response in the drive. CANE RIVER forwardly placed while three wide in the early going, retreated through the stretch. TOKALOSH was finished early. WEEKEND RULER trailed throughout.
