Footnotes

THEATRICAL'S HALO unhurried in the early going, encountered some traffic when moving a bit closer late in the final turn, angled in and accelerated through a hole inside the furlong marker, edged clear under continued firm handling. TOES THE LINE forwardly placed, advanced and took over three wide turning into the straight, gained command, could not contain the winner the final furlong, proved game for the place. DOCTOR BRASCH off the pace while saving ground, continued back into the lane, brief wait, moved out, late run through traffic and was going well at the end. FINDER'S CREEK allowed to settle early while off the inside, ranged up become a factor four wide in the second turn, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. TIZ A SCHOLAR lacked speed, came four wide into the straight, angled out a bit more, improved position late while widest at the wire. WAKKIANO narrowly set the pace while along the inside, continued to show the way into the lane, weakened the final furlong. WHOLELOTAKING raced one paced throughout while racing toward the inside. ANGELONMYSHOULDER (GB) vied up front while off the inside, between foes into the lane, gave way in the drive. INVISIBLE FORCE was never involved. SMILE FOR UR I D forwardly placed in the early going, steadily faded.
