NOT TOO PROUD narrowly set the pace while off the inside, disposed of the other speed exiting the turn, pulled away in the drive while being kept to task. STORM BOOT LARRY lacked early foot, rallied five wide when set down out of the turn, proved no match for the winner, well clear of the others. DUSTY TUNNEL broke out a bit, raced back, saved ground through the turn, angled out for the drive, staged a mild rally to annex the show. EXCLUSIVE ALLIANCE pressured the winner early, chased that same foe through the turn then began to give way. ELLUNA well back for a half, passed tiring foes while not a threat. ONE SLEET DEAL within striking distance early off the inside, had nothing for the drive. SAUCY LUCK flashed brief speed the opening quarter, began to back up before a half. SMOKING KIP four wide late in the turn when within striking distance of the first flight, gave way in the drive.
