Footnotes

ALLIE'S TABOO unhurried for six furlongs while saving ground, angled out and challenged three wide under clever handling into the stretch, proved best under firm handling. LATCH LIGHTING stalked the pace while outside, closer three wide late in the final turn, roused, outfinished in the late going. PRIETO JOLIE bumped at the start, raced well back, swung out to be six wide into the stretch, finished willingly down the middle of the strip while too late. GENTLEMAN DAN set or forced the pace off the inside, garnered a larger advantage late in the final turn, could not last. MANE MAN moved up after the start to vie for the lead closest to the inside, began to weaken midway on the second turn. MARION PONDEROSA was never dangerous. MALAGRA'S FOOL broke well, showed the way past the wire the first time, relinquished the advantage soon after, five wide when within striking distance turning for home, tired the final furlong. RED VENTURE broke out, bumped, midpack first quarter, finished early. ZARB'S GUNNER a bit rank just after the start, five wide turning for home, faded.
