R U'S GOLDEN LADY away in good order, allowed the leader to go, collared that foe from the outside in the turn, shook clear, driving. HOUSE OF STARS broke well, raced forwardly and inside, shuffled back turn, moved out a bit for the drive, finished willingly to earn the place. FILLEDBYHISGLORY off the early pace, came four wide out of the turn, also showed some late interest to rally for the show. BENTON ROAD settled off the pace, in some traffic late in the turn, improved a bit when clear for the drive. THREE SHADOWS off slowly, raced well back early as a result, fanned six wide out of the turn, improved while finding best stride too late. SPEED DANCER off a bit slow, middle move outside, failed to sustain that effort in the drive. T'S DREAM failed to menace. WINTER ROCKET off the pace, came five wide into the lane, roused, failed to respond. CHLOE'S A CHARMER sprinted well clear after an alert break, gave way when headed by the winner midway on the turn. FLASHYCIDUEP was never a factor.
