STARS OF FREEDOM settled in the second flight off the inside, challenged on the outside in the second turn,drove well clear in the stretch. JO'S THUNDER four wide first turn, again late in the second, no match for the winner, held sway for the place. POINT MINISTER lacked speed, split foes while four wide in the second turn, roused for the drive, angled in a bit and was gaining on the runner up. IMALWAYSRIGHT well off the pace, came five wide into the stretch, improved position. FIEND A BIT bothered at the start raced well back, saved ground, improved position while never dangerous. MARKET MOVER set or forced the pace off the inside, gave way in the drive. FEW CAN LAND off bit slow, five wide turning into the stretch, made little impact in the drive. MEAN MOTA SCOOTA four wide into the first turn, tired. THIS CAT'S LOADED broke to the outside, never a threat. GO FASTER FOREST faded. PLENTY O'JACK dueled inside, gave way before six furlongs. NASKRA DREAM N stopped in the far turn.
