**Footnotes**

STORM BOOT LARRY vied up front along the inside out of the chute, dueled into and through the turn while remaining closest to the inside, drew out through the lane under steady handling. KAT'S COURT closest to the two leaders early along the inside, continued to save ground through the turn, proved no match for the winner the final furlong, second best. LA PIANO MAN moved up to chase the dueling leaders into and through the turn while in the three path, had little for the winner in the drive, outkicked for the place spot. BUTTER BROWN settled off the pace and the inside, between horses in midpack through the turn, went evenly in the drive. AUTOBEACAT bobbed at the start, quickly recovered to vie for the lead, dueled outside the winner the middle three furlongs, weakened in the drive. JOHN'S BROWN BEAR off a bit slow, raced back, four out to five wide through the turn, passed tiring rivals. THE DIVINE TUNNEL lacked speed, tired four wide out of the turn. J. BURLE was finished early, trailed home.
