Footnotes

LAWSON'S LADY away in good order, got clear before a quarter, showed the way while off the inside into and through the turn while under restraint, responded when challenged from the inside, long drive, proved best in determined fashion. RUNNING SHOES dropped inside soon after the start, tracked the winner from along the rail through the turn, tired that one while remaining on the inside stretch, not good enough. WARRIOR MAID forwardly placed in some traffic, moved out just as DAWN'S TRIBUTE was angling a bit with a half mile to run, took up in tight quarters, fell back to trail, angled out to be widest for the drive when straightened for home, finished up willingly. A TRAINER'S CLAIM OF FOUL FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN THE RUN UP THE BACKSTRETCH WAS NOT ALLOWED. CAT'S PRODUCTION bobbled at the start, raced back off the pace, came four wide out of the turn, lacked a significant late response. DAWN'S TRIBUTE angled in slightly in some traffic after a quarter, fell back a bit in the turn, also came up empty when asked for the drive. MISS POLLY closest to the winner for a half, weakened in the drive.
