Footnotes

AMBROSE THE GREAT off a step slow, advanced in the turn toward the inside, angled out three wide for 5th drive, challenged inside the furlong marker and finished well to win going away. NATIVE DAZZLER off the early pace, lodged a bid along the rail turning for home, gained the advantage, proved no match for the winner late, clearly second best. KAYOSIDY pressured the early pace, continued to race forward while three wide through the turn, lacked a closing punch, best of rest. REDEYE lacked speed, raced five wide out of the turn, improved position through the stretch while not a serious threat. KYLES CRYPTO within striking distance outside, moved a bit closer while five wide late in the turn, failed to sustain that advance in the stretch. DOC STORM CAT broke alertly, set the pace off the inside, allowed the runner up the rail turning for home and began to tire. FIDDLEDEE prominent while four wide into and through the far turn, faded after a half. YOUNG AUSTIN off slow, raced well back, improved position by passing tiring rivals. HIGH MAGIC forwardly placed early in some traffic, backed up while seven wide late in the turn. TWO BAD BROTHERS tired while four wide. SOUTHERN PASSION was never close.
