FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$200 to pass the entry box on Wednesday, June 20 and an additional \$300 to start on Saturday, June 23 with \$50,000 (less payment of 1% to all Owners of horses finishing sixth through ninth - with any unpaid monies reverting to the purse account) Guaranteed of which the remaining 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth. Weights: Sunday, June 17. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Should this race not be divided and the entry number exceeds the starting gate capacity, high weights will be preferred. Different Owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second part of same Owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Nominations closed Friday, June 15, 2007 with 27 nominees. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 1 Mile and 70 Yards).

MIDDLEWEIGHT well off the pace off the inside, came five wide when beginning to rally into the lane, dug in late between foes, narrowly best. RUCKUS off the pace, six wide into the lane, finished willingly to miss. ERRONEOUS I D within striking distance outside, ranged up four wide to challenge second turn, bid, missed. SIR RABBIT pressed the leader off the inside, took over into the stretch, could not last. WAUPACA unhurried toward the inside, lacked room midstretch, did not recover. NORTHERN SCENE settled, moved up three wide in the second turn, hung in the drive. MATZOH TOGA popped his stall door prestart, pace, faltered in the drive. DREAMSANDVISIONS saved ground, bit closer while continuing inside late second turn, traffic stretch, weakened. EVENING REWARD finished early, well beaten.
