CARSON'S TWINKLE allowed the pace to go early, roused three wide and between foes when beginning to advance midway on the second turn, reached the front turning for home, long stretch duel, beginning to edge away late. LIVEALITTLEBIT prompted the pace while off the inside, ranged up to challenge three wide in the second turn, narrowly showed the way into the stretch, dueled inside the winner, second best. STILL QUICK lacked speed, swung out to be five wide turning for home, finished up willingly to be getting to the runner up late. SIPPI FEVER four wide and within striking distance first turn, continued to maintain contact with the leader, four wide second turn, came up empty for the drive. PINEY ROCK slow to start, trailed well back, picked off a couple of tiring foes after the issue had been decided. CATHYWITHAC pressured the early pace, gave way. RACHELSFINESTHOUR sprinted clear to show the way early, continued to set or forced the pace four six furlongs, stopped in the drive.
