ARCTIC COMET moved off the inside after allowing the leaders to go early, continued to stalk into the far turn, ranged up four wide to challenge turning for home, drew clear, kept to task. MASTER JEHU lacked speed, roused three wide turning for home, moved out a bit further for room midstretch, finished up willingly to be in time for the place. STORM OSIDY hustled away from the gate, cleared to the inside, dueled, vied into the lane while remaining closest to the rail, no match winner, nipped late for the place. FIEND A BIT settled off the pace while racing the in the two path, saved ground into the lane, lacked a serious closing kick. K D'S BIG MAC stalked the pace off the inside, briefly challenged three wide and inside the winner late in the final turn, faltered in the drive. I'M GOOD TO GO last away, remained back and was never a threat. SULTRY CROOK moved up to duel off the inside, stopped from between rivals entering the stretch.
