Footnotes

CHEF SCOTT vied early while between foes, fell back and raced in the second flight while well out in the strip turn, steered out for room inside the furlong marker, late bid, best. CAFE SKITDADDEL vied up front closest to the inside, held a narrow advantage in the two path late in the turn, proved stubborn to the wire. FOREVERSINGLE broke well, angled toward the inside, contested the issue up front throughout, drifted out a bit late, outfinished. SHOUTFORJOY with the pace, vied three wide turning for home, drifted out and weakened. KING'S DEPUTY settled off the pace, came three wide into the lane, improved position slightly while not a serious threat. ANGEL'S CHARIOT broke out, within striking distance for five furlongs along the inside, weakened in the drive. A P CASTELLI off the pace and the inside, five wide into the stretch, failed to rally. WHAT A BROTHER bothered slightly at the start, raced back early, improved slightly while never dangerous. RIVER OF ICE off a bit slow, trailed, outrun. MIDNIGHT REGRET in the second flight through the turn while between horses, gave way. A J'S FASHION finished early, trailed home.
