Footnotes

TRU FORTY WON back off the pace while racing outside, dropped in under clever handling early turn, got through an open rail turning for home, drew well clear, driving. DIFFERENTLY away in good order, pushed in when HAY DUDE came in exiting the chute forcing C D MILAGRO inward in turn, chased the leader, moved up inside to vie through the turn in the two path, allowed the winner the rail into the lane, could not match that rival, held sway for the place. SOVEREIGN KEY void of speed, came in the two path into the lane, moved to the rail, gaining for the place spot late. C D MILAGRO forwardly placed when forced in leaving the chute, moved out, closer four wide late in the turn, flattened out in the drive. SILKYS LAST DEAL within striking distance early, fell back a bit turn, five wide into the lane, lacked a late kick. HORNITO fell back to trail for a half, picked off a couple of faltering foes after the issue had been decided. HAY DUDE broke alertly, came in exiting the chute bothering inner rivals, got clear, vied up front in the three path turn, weakened in the drive. SLEW SALUTE finished early.
