Footnotes

THE MALLARD MAN allowed the pace to go early while under restraint, within striking distance second turn, blocked behind a wall of horses into the stretch, made a hole between foes a furlong out, edged clear. GO TIGER JACK prompted the pace early while four wide into the first turn, continued to press outside, took over into the stretch, brushed by the winner when he challenged between foes a furlong out, second best. GUILTY PLEA vied up front while between foes from the start, lasted for the show. WHISTLER'S DREAM off the pace and the inside, came four wide out of the final turn, lacked a closing punch. ST. RAPHAEL (IRE) narrowly set the pace along the inside after an alert break, faltered in the drive. QUICK SCORE last away, trailed throughout in a dull effort.
