COMBAT'S LOVE off the pace while along the inside, continued to save ground into the lane, challenged up the rail late, gained the nod. BUBBA PRINCESS void of early foot, made a nice move into contention while four wide in the second turn, took over, led late, nipped at wire. RIVAZ bobbed slightly at the start, raced forwardly and inside, lodged a bid along the rail far turn, showed the way into the lane two path, allowed the winner the rail nearing the furlong marker after being headed by the runner up, saved the show. BENTON ROAD within striking distance off the inside, moved a bit closer far turn, hung in the drive. ST SOUTHERN BELLE bore out into the first turn carrying GOLD RENE out with him, continued outside, stopped and finished well back. KINGS SALTWORKS off the pace, fell further back, well beaten. GOLD RENE carried out into the first turn when contesting the issue up front, got clear before a half, stopped second turn, distanced.
