Footnotes

IN MOTION behind the pace while along the inside, angled out to be three wide late in the turn, late burst on the outside to be in time. RACING CAJUN set or forced the pace while closest to the inside, garnered a larger advantage late, could not contain the winner. THE ASHMAN vied up front while outside, three wide through the turn, equal terms with the runner past the furlong marker, drifted a bit and weakened slightly late. LAGNIAPPE IN B S L lacked speed, saved ground through the turn, roused, improved while continuing along the rail. FIND THE TIME with the pace while between horses for three furlongs, tired in the drive. SKINT BACK off a step slow, failed to menace. VOO DOO LOVE broke alertly, raced forwardly well out in the course, five wide into the lane, tired. DADDY'S BOY in the second group while outside, tired four wide. MAUK SALT fell back after the start, trailed.
