GYPSY POLE E STYLE with the pace from the start while off the rail, larger advantage when straightened for home, responded when challenged from the outside by the runner up, turned that foe back late. IDA MARIA stalked the leaders outside, went after the winner upper stretch, challenged past the furlong marker, denied late. SASSY GAL lacked speed, came on the outside for the drive, finished best of the rest. VERY GIFTED fell back a bit the opening quarter along the inside, moved outside for the drive, improved a bit. SOOKSKI void of early foot, made little impact through the stretch. ANGEL BAYOU vied early, tired. BUTTER HEAD came up empty for the drive. GOODBYE BEAUTIFUL raced briefly forward, staged a steady retreat.
