MALABAR CROWN outrun in the early going, moved off the inside, began a four wide advance into the far turn, reached the leader when straightened for home, wore that foe down to be clear late. WHO DAT NATION closest to the two leaders for six furlongs, collared that pair with a three wide move turning for home, gained the advantage, narrowly showed the way past the furlong marker, could not match the winner late. MINNIRAHY forced out to be six wide briefly into the first turn, continued well wide, five wide out of the second bend when beginning a rally, up late for the show. COUNTRYBOYATHEART steered out to avoid a foe into the first turn carrying MINNIRAHY out, raced back while continuing outside, five wide out of the second turn, closest to the top two late, caught for the show final strides. BLANCO BILLY settled off the pace while between foes much of the way, waited behind tiring foes entering the stretch, split foes, lacked a serious late kick. COASTAL RALLY off a step slow, remained well back, found best stride too late. DOUBLEDOWNANWIN raced in the second flight outside, lacked a response through the stretch. KARATE GARRETT tired from early efforts. TRUETT'S REBEL dueled up front closest to the inside and gave way. ROMANTIC DEVIL dueled up front off the inside, also backed up when confronted by the runner up turning for home. BAROQUEN HEART steadied along the inside into the first turn, fell well back.
