ROCKGLEN broke out slightly to help tighten up a couple of outer foes. narrowly set the pace closest to the inside while under confident handling, pulled away the final furlong under steady handling. HIGH TONED bit tight at the start, with the pace while between foes and outside the winner early, dueled with that same rival through the turn and into the stretch, no match final furlong, remained clear for the place. MYNAMEISHAPPY pressured the top two from the outside, saved the show. CROWNED GENERAL went evenly throughout behind the first flight. WARREN'S DOVE lacked a response in the drive. WILBY'S RAY four wide much of the way, lacked a rally. LIGHTHOUSEINTHEBAY in tight at the start, trailed throughout.
