SEND AND RECEIVE allowed the pace to go early, made a confident move four wide to challenge midway on the second turn, gained the advantage, clear a furlong out, enough left to hold the runner up safe under firm handling. LEEOLA within striking distance, boxed in second turn inside the winner, advanced three wide when clear, set down for the drive and finished willingly to be slowly getting to the winner. A. P. THAT'S ME lacked speed, five wide turning for home, lodged a belated rally and finished up well to be up for the show. DANCINGWITHNOMUSIC off the pace, pace four wide into the stretch, missed the show. DIGNIFIED LADY got clear to set the pace before a quarter, daylight advantage the middle half, briefly responded when challenged in the second turn, could not last. ONWITHTHETUNNEL forwardly placed, challenged in the second turn, faltered in the drive. CLASSICWIND steadied early, fell far back, well beaten.
