IN A RUNAWAY off the early pace, made a strong move four wide to challenge late in the turn, put a head in front, lost the advantage midstretch, came back in determined fashion to prove best. CUZ JOLEE off a step slow, lodged a bold move into contention late in the turn and behind the winner, put a head in front with a furlong to run, outfinished. ILLUSIVE HEART broke out, bumped foe start, trailed for a half, made a late run through traffic to be well clear for the show. OUR DIVA FACTOR in the second flight toward the inside, in some traffic late in the turn, steered out a bit for room, went evenly to the wire. HIGH MAGIC chased the leader into the turn, moved up, challenged late in the bend, flattened out in the drive. INTINCTION in the second group off the inside, moved out to be widest for the drive, failed to rally. DEVIL'S RAGE broke in, bumped with foe, straightened and sprinted clear, gave way when headed turning for home. DEPUTY DOLITTLE jostled at the start, was finished early.
