BURT'S A STITCH with the pace early while between foes and in hand, got clear in the turn while still under slight restraint, steadily drew out down the lane under a moderate hand ride. ROYAL TREATY lacked speed, came on the outside for the drive, roused, up final strides for the place. ST. RAPHAEL (IRE) vied early three wide, chased the winner through the turn, could not keep up in the drive, nipped for the place at the wire. STONE SKIPPER evenly paced, dropped to the inside for the drive, lacked a significant late response. DUBLIN ROAD with the early pace outside, faded. THE DIVINE TUNNEL flashed brief speed along the inside, began to retreat before a half. MARQUIS MARKSMAN last away, trailed throughout.
