BATTLE SILK reserved off the pace, advanced four out to six wide late in the turn, lost some ground into the lane, got to the leaders with less than a furlong remaining, proved best under steady handling. GHOSTLY APPEAL within striking distance toward the inside, asked along in the two path late in the turn, came three wide into the stretch, challenged between rivals and inside the winner with just under a furlong remaining, second best. GRANNY ZEE broke alertly, set the pace, got clear in the turn, could not contain the top two the final furlong, remained clear of the others. LOLLIBON void of early foot, improved position without posing a serious threat. CHAPELLOU pressured the leader early, began to retreat before a half. SUSPECT SARA forwardly placed and outside, backed up. QUICK RULER in some early traffic off the pace, steadied repeatedly after a quarter, had nothing for the drive. DE FRISKY SEQUOIA last away, remained sluggish, distanced after losing contact with the field.
