LOGAN HALL stalked the leader while on the outside and four wide into the turn, continued forwardly into the stretch, challenged three wide past the furlong marker, edged clear under steady handling. MR. CENTERFOLD bobbed at the start, raced back off the pace toward the inside, challenged along the rail with a furlong to run, second best. NOPE settled off the pace while racing toward the inside through the turn, steered out for the drive, lacked a winning kick. JOHNNY reluctant to load, lacked early foot, behind horses turning into the lane, improved position when clear for the drive. CLINEY sprinted clear soon after the start, showed the way, gave way when headed with a furlong remaining. FRANS LUCKY ONE off the pace, came five wide out of the turn, failed to muster a late kick. HIT THE HIGHWAY off slowly, was always outrun. LONELY BULL tired while four wide.
